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

<p>12/08/24</p>	<p>Royal Navy STEM Event</p> 	<p>September 17th Navy STEM Event We've been in contact with the Ibrox Foundation about running a Navy Day at our reserve base in Govan on 17th September.</p> <p>It's open to everybody but ideally those over the age of 15.5 – as we have different protocols that we have to adhere to for pupils under that age. Below is a proposed plan of potential activities dependent on staff and equipment availability.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Climbing wall – Pupils are introduced to the basics of rock climbing using an auto-belay system. • PAC 24 Seaboat Simulators – 	<p>Activities we can offer are listed below. These are subject to change depending on numbers. I have the Risk Assessments for each activity, if you'd like me to send them over then please just let me know. The idea would be to have the pupils split into smaller groups of 6-8 and provide several stances where they would rotate round. Groups would spend around 30mins on each stance and then move round to the next.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Firefighting – All Royal Navy personnel are trained firefighters. This exercise allows the pupils to experience the initial actions 	<p>Additionally, we would be able to deliver presentations on what Basic Training is like, the recruitment process and have Q&A sessions with groups.</p> <p>Having spoken with the staff and considering the activities on offer:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • it is probably advisable that pupils arrive wearing casual clothing. • It is also advisable that they bring a water bottle with them. • Timings will depend on number of attendees, and we can lay on a buffet style lunch with drinks and refreshments if required. • Ideally, we'd like pupils over the age of 15.5 – If there are pupils under this age then we need to know – there are restrictions on how we approach potential recruits of different ages.

A seaboat is a rigid hulled inflatable boat carried by Frigates & Destroyers. They are used for boarding operations & rescue missions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Weapons Stance – This is a show & tell type scenario only with an introduction to the airsoft practice rifles and ranges used within Dalriada. Pupils would not be able to hold, touch or take photos. (happy to remove this if deemed inappropriate) 	<p>take on fighting a fire with an extinguisher (there's no real fire!), the scenario would dictate that the initial actions have been unsuccessful and we make what is called a "re-entry". The team get dressed in full fire-fighting gear, charge their firefighting hoses and advance on the fire to extinguish it.
